Purpose:

A permanent Working Group, answerable to the Parish Council with the purpose of scrutinising/ assessing all future planning applications and development associated issues within the Parish as well as those outside the Parish which might have an impact on the Parish, particularly those close to the Parish boundaries.

Process:

- The Working Group will develop a simple and easy to use template with which to identify if planning applications in the Parish/adjacent to the Parish are in sync [or not] with the policies of the Neighbourhood Plan
- The planning applications will be assessed against the Policies identified in the Neighbourhood Plan as well as the content of the Badwell Ash and Long Thurlow Design Guidance & Code
- The Working Group will provide a report to the Parish Council on each planning application [where relevant] and appropriate recommendations will be made in order that the Parish Council can submit the outcome of the assessment to the Planning Authority (currently Mid Suffolk District Council)
- The Working Group will monitor progress of any Planning Applications that are approved to ensure they are implemented in accordance with the Neighbourhood Plan and recommend how Section 106/CIL monies might best be used for the benefit of the Parish

Meeting Frequency:

The Working Group will meet on an ad hoc basis, i.e. as and when there is/are planning applications to review
