



WALSHAM COMMUNITY FOOD BANK

Due to ever increasing demand our local Food Bank based in Walsham is no longer sustainable. Of late we have been distributing four times the amount of food donated which regularly involves purchasing £1,000 worth of food a month. Our service is totally reliant upon volunteers who purchase, collect, store, package and distribute food to around eighty individuals each month as well as undertaking all the associated administration and following some recent changes in personnel this is now proving to be an insurmountable task.

Sadly, against this background we have decided to close down our local operation at the end of June and transfer all our remaining food stocks and funds to Stowmarket Foodbank who will then service our benefice from their significantly larger operation at New Life Church (Suffolk), 4 Pochard close, Stowmarket IP14 5EX.

Food donations can continue to be placed in our benefice churches and these will then be collected and delivered to Stowmarket.



CITIZENS ADVICE



We've booked a package holiday to Spain. It's our first time booking this sort of getaway, and a friend recently had a terrible experience when things went wrong on a similar trip. What sort of help is available if something does go wrong?

Hopefully you'll have a lovely time but if something does go wrong with your package holiday, the National Citizens Advice website at citizensadvice.org.uk/consumer has lots of information about what to do if something goes wrong with your holiday and what compensation you may be eligible for.

Firstly, tell the company or travel agent you booked with as soon as possible. This way you're more likely to be able to get it sorted quicker. If you don't say anything until you get home, you might get less or no compensation at all.

If the holiday you went on turned out to be lower in value than the one you originally booked you can make a claim for 'loss of value'. For example you paid for a deluxe room but only got a standard one, if it wasn't sorted out at the time you can claim back the difference in value.

You can also claim compensation for any extra money you have to spend while away, for example the hotel was a bus ride away from the beach rather than across the road as advertised. This is called claiming for 'out-of-pocket expenses'. If this does happen make sure you keep all your receipts for things like bus journeys.

If big parts of the trip you booked didn't happen or services weren't provided, for example a planned two-day excursion was cancelled and no alternative was organised, you can make a claim for 'loss of enjoyment'. You can also make this claim if something happens that causes you distress or disappointment, such as the pool was closed for the whole trip.

It's worth noting that there's no there's no strict guidance on how much you can claim for loss of enjoyment but any claim you make must be reasonable. You can't get compensation if you simply didn't enjoy the holiday or if the problem was out of the holiday company's control - like bad weather.

Check the information you received when you made the booking to see what you're supposed to get. If you don't get the service you've been promised, you may be entitled to compensation for breach of contract. You might also be able to claim from your travel insurance – check if your policy covers this.

RECIPES

(Too many courgettes growing? Try these recipes)

ELDERFLOWER AND COURGETTE CAKE

Ingredients

250g soft unsalted butter, 250g caster sugar, 1tsp vanilla extract, zest and juice 2 large lemons, 5tbsp elderflower cordial, 300g plain flour, 2tsp baking powder, 5 eggs, 150g courgettes (about 1-2 small ones) finely grated, 25g icing sugar, 75g granulated sugar

Method

- 1. Preheat over to 160c, fan 140c, Gas 3. Grease and line a deep 20cm round cake tin.
- 2. Beat together the softened butter and caster sugar until pale and creamy. Beat in vanilla extract, half the lemon zest, 1 tablespoon lemon juice and 2 tablespoons of elderflower cordial.
- 3. Sift the flour, baking powder and salt into another bowl. Beat the eggs into the creamed mixture one by one, add a tablespoon of flour if the mixture curdles, then mix in the flour.
- 4. Fold in the grated courgette. Pour into prepared tin and bake for 1hr 10 min to 1hr 20mins or until a skewer poked into the centre comes out clean.

Cool in the tin for 10-15mins then put onto wire rate over a plate.

5. Skewer holes across the top of cake. Mix together remaining lemon juice and zest with cordial. Quickly mix in icing sugar and all but 1 tbsp of granulated sugar. Spoon sugary syrup all over the top of the cake. Sprinkle reserved granulated sugar over the top and leave the cake to cool.

CHEESEY COURGETTE MUFFINS

Ingredients

1 small courgette, 100g (3 ½ fl oz) light cheddar cheese 225g (8oz) S R Flour, 50ml / 2 floz olive oil 175ml / 6 floz semi-skimmed milk, 1 egg, black pepper



Method

- 1. Pre-heat over to Gas 6, 200c fan 108c
- 2. Grate courgette and then cheese into mixing bowl.
- 3. Add SR flour along with oil and milk, mix well.
- 4. Beat egg in separate bowl with black pepper then add to other ingredients.
- 5. Spoon into 12 muffin cases . Cook for approx. 20 minutes. Cool on cooling tray.

JULY ON THE ALLOTMENTS

The weather continues to make growing at the allotment interesting; cold winds of May and early June seem a distant memory, with June being the hottest on record for the UK. All 7 water butts that had filled with rain over the winter and early spring were now empty. Thankfully some heavy showers in mid and late June have refilled the water butts a bit and refreshed the ground and the plants growing.

The allotments are now thriving with a patch work of potatoes in full flower, courgette plants with huge triffid like leaves, runner beans racing to the top of their wigwams and sweetcorn growing tall and lush. Sweet peas have done really well this year. I trying to find different ways to eat my way through a forest of purple curly Kale each meal time.

Autumn sown Broad beans and garlic are now harvested leaving a bare patch of ground. An opportunity to follow on with leeks, a last sowing of French beans, and some salad leaves perhaps.

Rocket, pak choi, mustard leaves are worth sowing now for salad leaves – less likely to go to seed as the days shorten.

Spring cabbage and Kale can be sown at this time of year too, to provide greens over the winter months and into spring.

Sharing my plot with a friend has been a good idea – the full plot is too big to manage when you work full time. We both have our own patch of ground for vegetables but we have planted a new fruit garden together, share the existing 6 fruit trees and have made a new chicken run for our 3 chickens beneath the apple trees. The chickens are laying well with 3 eggs a day so enough for 2 families at the end of a week.

The polytunnel is providing some French beans and salad, but I await the first cucumber and tomato - lesson learnt that I was a bit late at changing over from the winter /early spring vegetables to get the tomatoes in their place. Note to self to be ruthless and remove the winter salad and plant earlier next year.


