#### THE BELLS OF ST MARGARET'S CHURCH, WESTHORPE

On a glorious Sunday morning in late June, the sound of church bells rang joyfully out across the village and fields of Westhorpe calling the people to church. The pealing of St Margaret's bells had not been heard in Westhorpe on a Sunday for a century so this was a special day.

At the time of the First World War, the ancient bell frame was deemed no longer fit for purpose and apart from occasional chiming, the bells became redundant. Over the succeeding decades, PCCs had sought quotations and then recoiled in horror at the cost of restoration but when we learnt the National Lottery Heritage Fund were giving consideration to funding church bell restoration, it seemed worth a try. Foundries were contacted and recent bell restoration projects across the county visited before we accepted a quotation from John Taylors Bell Foundry in Loughborough.

A small steering group of six was formed in the summer of 2021 and our A-peal for Mary Tudor was launched in the village hall in the October. Local residents and friends of the village gave their full support as did members of the Suffolk Guild of Ringers. We received notice of our award from the National Lottery Heritage Fund in February 2023 and soon after the bell hangers began their work of lowering the old bells for their journey to Loughborough.

In April 2024, six smart bells were returned to the church. Among these six, two had been recast, one was brand new and one donated by the Keltek Trust, an organisation that refers to itself as a dating agency for bells. In our case, the donated bell was from a church in Stafford who no longer had need of it. Our most precious bell is listed and was cast at the Foundry in Bury St Edmunds in the early 1500s. Mary Tudor, Queen of France, who resided at Westhorpe in this period would have heard this particular bell ringing out and we refer to it as *The Mary Tudor Bell*; hence the name of our appeal.

A service of Rededication of the Bells will take place at St Margaret's, Westhorpe on Wednesday, 4th September, 2024 at 6.00pm. The Right Reverend Martin Seeley, Bishop of St Edmundsbury and Ipswich will officiate. We would welcome all from across the Benefice to join us for this service of celebration.



#### NOTES FROM THE GARDEN

Hello, it's been a challenging few months weather wise, we are probably 3 weeks behind on our allotment, but nature and the weeds will catch up.

Gardening is a wonderful way of destressing everyday life, people often refer to it as therapeutic, others say it has changed their lives for the good. After a few hours at the allotment or in your own garden, take time to sit down and observe what you have achieved and walk away with a great feeling inside yourself.

Salvias scabious and other such perennials will benefit by being chopped by a third after the first flowers fade, this will produce a bushier plant and more flowers.

Pick young vegetables like beetroot, it will encourage bigger beet for preserving.

Cut herbs before flowering, hang in a dry warm place then strip off the leaves and seal in an air tight container, or freeze in ice blocks for future stews or soups, this can also apply to excess peppers as well.


Dig up and store your potatoes, what a great sight to look back to see rows of spuds drying on the soil after your efforts to nurture them, place in a paper or hessian sack and store in a cool but frost free shed onions after dried completely treat the same way.

Things to do in August collect seeds from flowers in the garden place in a marked envelope leaving some to attract wild life and self-seed, leave ornamental grass seed heads on for birds and structure.

Things to do in September feed and deadhead baskets and containers as these will flower till the first frost. Also plant daffodils crocus and hyacinths now.

Finally on August bank holiday Sun/Mon Walsham-Le-Willows open gardens weekend is on again, money raised goes to St Marys church and local charities. My wife and myself have previously opened our garden and again this year will open our gates, to share our garden. Please come and see us, to take a look and ponder over plants and ideas, hope to see you.

Q – Are next of kin responsible for care home fees after a family member dies?


**A** – When a resident dies in a care home, next of kin will not have to pay any outstanding care home fees, this will be taken from the deceased person's estate unless a specific contract has been signed with the care home, saying you will pay instead.

Q – My parents are thinking of moving into a retirement home and we are looking to find out as much as we can about them, costs to buy or rent, maintenance charges and what else is available on site for social activity, etc. Where should we begin to look for information?

**A** – A good place to begin is to visit www.Lottie.org. This organisation offers a free service that helps families and retirees find the UK's best elderly care homes and retirement living communities in line with a person's wishes.

I've just had my bathroom retiled, but I'm not happy with the work.

At first, things seemed to be going well, but then the tradesperson left to do another job and I had to chase them for updates. They did eventually come back and finish the job, but the work was rough around the edges. They also left all the old tiles and plaster for me to dispose of, which I wasn't expecting. I've now got the invoice, but I don't think the price reflects the work done or the service I got. Can I challenge this?

It's always frustrating when you run into problems with home improvements. If the work is to a degree you consider to be unfinished or unsafe, you should be able to get the tiler to come back to fix it.

Under the Consumer Rights Act 2015, that Act says that work, in this case by a tiler, should have been completed with 'reasonable care and skill'. If this isn't the case, then the law has been broken. You are legally entitled to ask that the problem is fixed (if they provided the tiles as well as the service, as in this case) or get money refunded (if they just provided the service and you bought the tiles). Either way, the tiler should fix the problem or refund you in a reasonable amount of time, without causing too much inconvenience. As you've received the invoice for the work but not paid yet, now would be a good time to ask them to fix the issue or you can negotiate a lower price for the work.

Speak to them in person or contact them in writing/email. Template letters can be found on the Citizens Advice website. Take photographs of the problem. Make notes about what happened, including dates and times. And gather any paperwork and receipts. You can find more information on the Citizens Advice website about steps you can take, including using 'alternative dispute resolution', which is a way of solving disagreements without going to court.
