

PART-TIME VACANCIES

Badwell Ash Parish Council

Badwell Ash lies between Bury St Edmunds, Ixworth, Stowmarket and Diss and has a population of around 900.

The Parish Council is an elected corporate body, with variable tax raising powers, and carries out beneficial public activities such as meeting local needs for amenities such as benches and war memorials, involvement in development planning, providing sports facilities, and speed monitoring.

The roles: Parish Clerk - and - Finance Officer

Previously these two roles have been filled by a single person working 18 hours per week. For 2025 we have separated the roles and wish to recruit 2 people, who can work flexibly on part-time hours.

Both roles will now be formally advertised across the area.

Personal qualities

For both roles the most needed qualities are good listening, communication skills, team working, and willingness to learn new skills.

Full training will be provided: we are keen to help post-holders develop skills and we will fund their working towards recognised qualifications.

Location

Badwell Ash Parish council does not own an office property, and candidates will be expected to work from home.

Because the Clerk's role centres on many face-to-face interactions within the parish, we would much prefer the post holder to live within 30 minutes drive of Badwell Ash.

The Finance role might be filled from up to an hour's drive.

Responsibilities

<u>Parish Clerk</u> - Responsible for Parish matters; as the professional guide to the Parish Councillors on decision-making, and how our meetings are run.

Needed at all monthly (evening) meetings of the Parish Council. The Clerk must be a well-organised person who takes notes at our meetings to produce a record of decisions and actions, and manages our other employees and smaller contracts.

<u>Finance officer</u> - Acts as lead on our finances, buying, spending and forecasting. Expected to prepare a report in advance of Council meetings, but may not need to be present. Any background experience of book-keeping or accountancy would be very helpful.

The Finance Officer must be a methodical person, able to correctly record, analyse and summarise finance and spend records including VAT (we are not VAT-registered) and to construct budgets, so that we always know how we are doing, and can plan more than 1 year ahead.

Working patterns

Working hours for both posts will be flexible, reflecting individual needs and work-life balance. We welcome applications from people who are willing to work from home, and may already work part-time.

<u>The Clerk</u> - Estimated 12 hours per week, plus a few special meetings e.g. to brief the councillors before major decisions.

<u>The Finance Officer</u> - Estimated 6 hours per week, plus a smaller number of additional meetings to e.g. to brief the councillors before major decisions such as annual audit and budget cycle.

UK CARE SECTOR

Question – Can I find out what personal information is held about me from my Council Social Services Department?

Answer – Yes, you can request a copy of the information held about you, called a Subject Access Request (SAR). This could include your housing file, social care file and any other information held about you by the Council. Currently, GDPR does not specify any time limitation for a data subject requesting their personal data and usually there is no fee to pay. The time limit for responding to a subject access request (SAR) is usually one month from the day the organization receives the request

Question - My Father, now in his late 70's, has different sized feet. We find it difficult to buy footwear for him other than buying two pairs of shoes in different sizes. My local shoe shop has closed so cannot ask them for any information, can you advise where we could look?

Answer – There are online shoe retailers who can help, one of which is Tripalot. They are an online store providing footwear for those who require odd-sized pairs or just a single shoe, they also sell same sized pairs. Their website is https://www.tripalot.co.uk

Question – I am finding that climbing my stairs at home is becoming more difficult and I am thinking about getting a stair lift but know nothing about them. How can I get advice about this and possibly other helpful equipment for my home?

Answer – Stair lifts, other equipment and adaptations are changes you can make to your home to make it safer and easier to move around and do everyday tasks.

Your local council offers a service that assesses your home and recommends changes to help, stair lifts are included. It is called Home Assessment, it is free and carried out by an Occupational Therapist, usually taking about an hour. You can call your local Council to arrange, or you can apply online by going to: NHS UK – home adaptions – social care and support guidance.

NOTES FROM THE GARDEN

Hello again, when I wrote last time about how I'd managed to do some digging at the allotment because of the milder winters, I'd forgotten about the wet weather which comes with milder seasons, it has been awful. The allotment is like a marsh even on the raised beds, making it impossible to even stand upon, however the water will eventually soak down to the subsoil and help in the initial spring sowings when the weather gets warmer.

Snowdrops, winter aconites and crocus have finished their colourful display, now's the time to dig up and separate them and plant elsewhere when the leaves are still green thus providing more plants in your garden. Time now to think about placing more water collecting containers around your house and gardens on sheds and outhouses, it's surprising how much this produces to help water your seeds and plants in spring and summer.

If you have fruit trees or large shrubs clear around the base and mulch around them, be careful not to touch the trunks. February is time to cut back ornamental grasses before new growth appears, also prune back hard shrubs like buddleia to improve shape and size restriction.

March is time to prune roses cutting out dead wood and weak stems, cut down to a lower bud with a slanting cut away from the bud. Deadhead daffodils leaving the foliage to replenish the bulbs, or as I do and lift out planted pots pop them to one side leaving a space to fill in your garden.

Now is the time to sow chilli and tomato seeds. Last year my wife purchased a set of propagators complete with adjustable led lights. Placing seeds in the module's and putting the plastic cover complete with lights switched on we were amazed at how quick and successful this was.

Get ahead on the allotment by sowing broad beans and onion sets in induvial pots, we use the carboard inners of toilet rolls filled with compost, you then can plant these straight into the soil when ready.

By the time you read this, the days will be longer, the sunlight stronger, bringing forth a new gardening year full of hope wonder, and WEEDS.

CITIZENS ADVICE



Are you looking for a new car for work, but can't afford to buy a new one, so you've been looking at second-hand options?

For many people, buying a car is a major purchase and whether it's new or second-hand, the process can seem daunting and complicated. But don't worry, there's lots of information on the steps to take when buying a car and what you can do afterwards if something goes wrong on the Citizens Advice.

First, where are you going to buy the car? If buying from a trader, choose a trustworthy one with an established name with a good reputation. Ideally, they will be part of a trade association or follow the industry's code of practice.

If buying via an auction, this is much riskier as you'll have fewer legal protections like the right to returns or refunds so carefully read the terms and conditions before you bid.

If buying from a private seller, there's a few extra steps to take. For instance, try to inspect the car at their home address so if something goes wrong later, you have a record of that.

Make sure the car's details are correct by using the DVLA's free online vehicle information checker. You'll need the registration number, MOT test number, mileage and make/model of the car to do this check. Also, check the car's MOT history. Keep a copy of both these results (take a screenshot or download the information) as well as the original advert or description of the car. You might also consider getting a private history check to see if the car's been reported stolen, still has money owing on it, or has been in a serious crash.

Inspecting the car is crucial before buying. Ideally, do this during the day when it's not raining (scratches are harder to see on a wet car) and take it for a test drive for at least 15 minutes and on different types of roads if possible. Check you have the appropriate insurance for a test drive (either your own or the seller's policy might cover you).

Once you've decided on a car, don't be afraid to negotiate on the price. If you take out a loan or finance to buy it, make sure you can afford the repayments over the lifetime of the contract. If you pay with cash, you will have fewer protections than other options like debit.

Often, despite doing all these checks, you might find something wrong with the car after you've bought it. You may have a legal right to a repair, the cost of a repair or some money back but it's on a case-by-case basis.
