Patrick's obvious enthusiasm for the development of a way to farm commercially whilst respecting the land and preserving it for future productivity, had us all spell bound. His talk was filled with a myriad of facts and figures from his encyclopaedic knowledge of everything, from moths to beetles and birds. (We marvelled at a survey revealing seventeen different kinds of hover fly!) We learned that Lodge Farm is a member of LEAF (linking environment and farming) and also NFFN (nature friendly farming network). Patrick and cousin Brian, one a farmer/conservationist and the other a conservationist/farmer have together established green corridors and wild flower margins for wild life movement, (enjoyed by grey partridge). They have restored many ponds (helping crested newts) and reduced machinery and installed energy saving solar power. All while running a commercially successful farm where some of the grain may well have ended up in your breakfast cereal, thanks to Shredded Wheat and other well-known brands.



CITIZENS ADVICE



I need a new car for work but I can't afford to buy a new one so I've been looking at second-hand options. I've heard so many horror stories about people buying cars that turn out to be faulty. I'm worried that I won't know what to check, especially as I know very little about cars. How can I make sure I don't buy a dud car?

For many people, buying a car is a major purchase and whether it's new or second-hand, the process can seem daunting and complicated.

First of all, where are you going to buy the car? If you're buying from a trader, choose a trustworthy one with an established name with a good reputation. Ideally, they will be part of a trade association or follow the industry's code of practice.

If you're buying via an auction, this is much riskier as you'll have fewer legal protections like the right to returns or refunds so carefully read the terms and conditions before you bid.

If you buy from a private seller, there's a few extra steps to take. For instance, try to inspect the car at their home address so if something goes wrong later, you have a record of that.

Make sure the car's details are correct by using the DVLA's free online vehicle information checker. You'll need the registration number, MOT test number, mileage and make/model of the car to do this check. Also, check the car's MOT history for free on gov.uk/get-vehicle-information-from-dvla.

Keep a copy of both these results (take a screenshot or download the information) as well as the original advert or description of the car. You might also consider getting a private history check to see if the car's been reported stolen, still has money owing on it, or has been in a serious crash. This will cost about £20.

Inspecting the car is crucial before buying. Ideally, do this during the day when it's not raining (scratches are harder to see on a wet car) and take it for a test drive for at least 15 minutes and on different types of road, if possible. Check you have the appropriate insurance for a test drive (either your own or the seller's policy might cover you).



Don't be afraid to haggle on the price, and only pay what you can afford. Make sure you get the original (not a photocopy) of the log book and valid MOT test certificate. Never buy a car without the log book.

Often, despite doing all these checks, you might find something wrong with the car after you've bought it. You may have a legal right to a repair, the cost of a repair or some money back but it's on a case-by-case basis. If something has gone wrong with your car and you need help, you can call the Citizens Advice consumer helpline on 0808 2231133.

APPLE, CHEESE AND POTATO PIE

Ingredients

30g salted butter, 1 tbsp vegetable oil,
2 large onions halved and finely sliced, ½ a bunch of thyme
30g plain flour, 500ml vegetable stock
1tbsp wholegrain mustard, 1 tbsp white wine vinegar
450g potatoes cut into 2-3cm chunks
3 apples peeled cored and chopped into 1-2cm chunks
150g mature cheddar grated

For the pastry

300g plain flour, plus extra for dusting 70g cheddar, grated 150g cold butter cut into cubes 1 egg beaten



Method

Make pastry. Tip the flour, cheese and a pinch of salt into a large bowl and mix. Add butter and rub in until the mixture resembles breadcrumbs. Mix in 4-5 tbsp cold water, bring together into a dough. Wrap and chill for 30 mins.

Make the filling, melt the butter in a saucepan add oil and cook onions for 10-15 mins until caramelised. Add the thyme leaves and fry for 1 min. Tip in the flour and combine, then gradually stir in the stock adding small amounts to prevent lumps forming. Simmer for 10 mins stirring occasionally. Stir in the mustard and vinegar towards the end of the cooking time.

Meanwhile boil the potatoes for 4-5 mins until just cooked and still holding their shape. Drain well and stir into the sauce. Add the apples, cheddar and some seasoning, mix well. Pour the filling into a 28cm baking dish.

Heat the oven to 200c/180c fan/gas 6. Roll out the pastry on a surface lightly dusted with flour to the thickness of a £1 coin. Cut into strips approximately 1cm wide. Lay half the strips across the dish horizontally leaving gaps in between, then weave in remaining strips vertically one by one to form a lattice effect. Brush with beaten egg.

Bake for 30 mins, until the pastry is golden brown. Leave to cool for 10 min before serving.


